Czech Mol Role in ICT

- effective 2007
 - central state administration body in charge of public administration information systems
 - coordination body for information and communication technologies
- fundamental objectives
 - modernisation of public administration
 - reaching an efficient public administration by use of ICT





Czech eGovernment


- smart public administration (PA)
 - better legislation
 - functioning authorities
 - professional public servants
 - efficient information technologies

Czech eGovernment Strategies

- Smart Administration (2007 2013)
 - defining the process of Czech PA modernisation and improvement via
 - o efficient use of ICT
 - o provision of high-quality public services
- eGov 2014+ (2014 2020)
 - strategic framework for the development of public administration and eGovernment 2014+
 - modern PA is designed
 as transparent and efficient service to the citizen
 - o the main principle is sharing data and services

PA Basic Registers System

- Act No. 111/2009 Coll., on basic registers
- 4 basic registers of public administration
 - Register of Inhabitants (Mol)
 - Register of Corporatons (Czech Statistical Office)
 - Register of Rights and Obligations (Mol)
 - Register of Territorial Identification,
 Addresses and Real Estates
 (Czech Office for Surveying, Mapping and Cadastre)
- Basic Registers Information System (Mol)
- ORG (The Office for Personal Data Protection)
- fully operational in July 2012



The Czech NSDI


- general spatial data on territory (COSMC)
 - RÚIAN (reference)
 - cadastral maps, state maps, ZABAGED (Fundamental Base of Geographic Data), ...
- special spatial data (both public and private)
 - national INSPIRE infrastructure (MoE)
 - statistical spatial data (CSO)
 - spatial data on technical infrastructures etc.
- systematic, transparent and formal determination of the Czech NSDI is missing up to now
- lack of

National Geoinformation Strategy





Towards Geoinformation Strategy



- first analysis of NSDI in 2001 (Nemoforum)
- Ministry of Informatics tried hard to go on but with no success
- first turnpoint was 2007
 - INSPIRE adoption
 - Mol took over the responsibility for ICT
- INSPIRE transposition between 2007 and 2009



INSPIRE



- INSPIRE transposition and implementation in responsibility of Ministry of the Environment (MoE)
 - transposition executed by update of Act No. 123/1998 Coll., on right of environmental information



- www.geoportal.gov.cz
- INSPIRE coordination body (KOVIN)
- INSPIRE became true Mol inspiration on the way towards national geoinfo strategy



Key PA Authorities' Agreement

- unstable political situation after 2010 election
- second turnpoint in mid-2012
- agreement on cooperation in the process of drawing up national geoinfo strategy
 - under Mol coordination MINISTERSTV
- - without any public money











 Minister of the Interior submitted the joint proposal for Czech Government's approval in October 2012





GeoInfoStrategy

- Czech Government
 - approved the proposal of working out of the "Strategy of spatial information infrastructure development in the Czech Republic up to 2020" (GeoInfoStrategy) by Resolution No. 837 on November the 14th, 2012
 - ordered to submit the GeoInfoStrategy draft for approval by the end of February 2014
 - ordered to cooperate to all central state administration bodies
 - recommended to cooperate to regions and cities





GeoInfoStrategy Main Goals

- to set up effective coordination and integration of public bodies and commercial sector activities in the field of spatial data
- to help to set up conditions for
 - major improvement of eGovernment services regarding spatial data
 - reduction of costs of public administration
 - enhancing of the overall competitiveness of the Czech economy





GeoInfoStrategy Contents

Implementation Plan

- description of NSDI current state,
 list of key problems and analysis of their causes
- defining target state that contains clear priorities and measurable goals (SMART)
- proposal of specific arrangements and tasks for reaching target state
 - Legislative and organisation arrangements
 - Arrangement administrators
 - Work breakdown and scheduling
 - Costs and Benefits of the arrangement realisation
- specification of roles of relevant PA bodies and user groups
- institutional definition of suitable coordination structure

 - Processing Team experts from PA and academic sphere






GeoInfoStrategy – Where we are

 - vision and global goal (linked to eGovernment goals)
 - priority areas
 - strategic goals
 - measures





Top impulse

- to enable access to elementary spatial data in the greatest detail
 - image of real status of Czech territory
 - legislation
 - process definition for data entry, management and update
 - binding input for public administration execution
